

Special Meeting
August 10, 2015

A special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Homer to award the bid on an addition to the Highway Garage held on Monday, August 10th, 2015, was called to order by Supervisor Frederick J. Forbes, Sr., at 9:00 a.m.

Supervisor Forbes reviewed the two bids that were received and opened on August 5th from Complete Construction Concepts, LLC, (CCC) and Fingerlakes Construction, Inc., both of Homer.

Attorney Snyder questioned whether the project required an environmental review and how it was being funded. Since the new building will be replacing an existing storage building with only an additional 16 feet being added, it was determined that an environmental review was not required. Snyder said that it would be a Type II action under the SEQRA regulation (6 NYCRR Part 617). Supervisor Forbes explained that the building was being funded through current appropriations in place of purchasing new Highway equipment.

On motion by Councilman Williams, seconded by Councilman Weddle and carried unanimously:
RESOLVED: that the low bid of CCC, LLC, of \$68,000 without the option is hereby accepted, with funds to be used from current appropriations of the Highway Fund – Outside Village (DB), and that the construction of the garage addition be declared a Type II action under SEQRA.

The special meeting was adjourned at 9:15 a.m.
