Supervisor Forbes explained that the Town was once again considering applying for a Community Development Grant from the New York State Office of Community Renewal under funding by the federal Small Cities Community Development Program. He said that the Town has applied for this same funding at least five other times and not been awarded any funds. The Town would be applying for \$500,000 which would help 15 to 20 homeowners repair their homes. These funds would be administered by Thoma Development Consultants who would also be writing the application for the Town, although at a reduced cost from last year.
