A special meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Homer to open bids for the Alterations to the Town Hall project held on Monday, August 20, 2018, in the board room of the Town Hall Building was called to order by Supervisor Frederick J. Forbes, Sr., at 2:00 p.m.

Architect Randy Crawford and Town Clerk Jebbett opened and read the bids received for each aspect of the proposed office renovation project - general contracting, electrical, plumbing and HVAC (see attached for details) – as follows:

1. W.L. Kline, Inc., Binghamton –general contracting - \$369,778 for base bid
2. Daniel J. Lynch, Inc., Endwell – general contracting-\$558,000 for base bid
3. Diamond & Thiel Construction Co., Inc., Syracuse-general contracting - \$380,000 for base bid
4. Marchuska Brothers Construction, LLC, Endicott-general contracting - \$756,000 for base bid
5. Bouley Associates, Inc., Auburn – general contracting - \$377,000 for base bid
6. Beard Electric, LLC, Cortland – electrical - \$57,360 for base bid
7. Patricia Electric, Inc., Syracuse – electrical - \$79,500 for base bid
8. Billitier Electric, Rochester – electrical - \$65,600 for base bid
9. K&B Plumbing and Heating Co., Cortland – plumbing - \$25,650 for base bid
10. K&B Plumbing and Heating Co., Cortland – HVAC - \$66,750 for base bid

The Town Board thanked all the bidders for their interest in the Town’s project. The Board discussed the bids and asked Crawford to further review them, along with the alternates, and report back to them. Supervisor Forbes scheduled the bid award for a special meeting to be held at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, August 27<sup>th</sup>.
