On motion by Supervisor Forbes, seconded by Councilmember Park and carried unanimously:
RESOLVED: that the Town Board accepts with regret the resignation of Town Clerk Anita W Jebbett due to her retirement on March 30th, 2021.

On motion by Supervisor Forbes, seconded by Councilmember Jones and carried unanimously:
RESOLVED: that the Town Board accepts with regret the resignation of Deputy Town Clerk Karen J Livingston due to her retirement on March 31st, 2021.

Supervisor Forbes noted the long service, 34 years, of Town Clerk Jebbett and the knowledge and experience that will be missed, and his appreciation of Deputy Town Clerk Livingston's 10 years of service. He said that a search for a new Town Clerk is now underway and that he and Councilmember Park will be interviewing any candidates.

On motion by Supervisor Forbes, seconded by Councilmember Warren and carried unanimously:
RESOLVED: that Anita W Jebbett is re-appointed as the Town Clerk/Tax Collector/Registrar as of April 1st, 2021, to serve as long as necessary to train a new appointee.

On motion by Supervisor Forbes, seconded by Councilmember Williams and carried unanimously:
RESOLVED: that Karen J Livingston is re-appointed as the Deputy Town Clerk/Tax Collector/Registrar as of April 1st, 2021, to serve on occasion as long as necessary.

Town Historian Martin Sweeney noted that Clerk Jebbett's grandfather, J Henry Knobel, had also served many years as Town Clerk, from 1934 to 1965, noting that there is a long family history of service to Homer that has lent stability to the Town's government.

Town Clerk Jebbett thanked Historian Sweeney for his kind words and noted that she has truly enjoyed working for the Town and its residents over the past many years.
