General bills were approved as audited on motion by Councilman Williams, seconded by Councilman Young and carried unanimously: **RESOLVED: that General vouchers #323 through #352 totaling \$84,838.29 be approved for payment.**

TRIBUTE TO WILLIAM WRIGHT

**WHEREAS, due to his steadfast leadership from 1980 through 2003, the Town of Homer saw improvements to the Town Hall, the Highway Garage, and Highway Department equipment while maintaining a low tax rate for its residents; and**

**WHEREAS, it has been because of his careful stewardship of the Town's funds that the current Town Hall additions and renovations have been possible;**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the Town Board of the Town of Homer hereby honors the memory of the steady and effective leadership of William H. Wright.**

NEW BUSINESS

Annual Appointments - Supervisor Forbes listed those Town positions which will be up for re-appointment in January.

Village complaint regarding Town Hall air quality - Forbes said that the Town has now received official notification that the Village will be vacating their offices entirely as of March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011. He said that the Town's insurance company, the Reagan Agency, Marcellus, has been contacted regarding the Notices of Claim filed against the Town by the Village Mayor and four employees claiming damages from carbon monoxide. Testing done by an independent company Microbac Laboratories and by the State Health Department showed virtually no carbon monoxide present in the offices and a level well below the legal limit in the Town boiler room.
