A RESOLUTION TO ENCUMBER SLFRF ARPA FUNDS

The following Resolution was offered by \_\_\_\_\_ and seconded by \_\_\_\_\_:

WHEREAS, the Town of Homer, in the County of Cortland, State of New York, founded in 1794, received State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) as Authorized through the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), in the amount of \$ 318,870.84 hereinafter referred to as the "ARPA Funds"; and

WHEREAS, the budget provides a complete financial plan for Fiscal Year 2025 and contains estimates of anticipated revenues and proposed expenditures for the upcoming fiscal year including funds provided by the American Rescue Plan Act; and

WHEREAS, recipients of ARPA funds must obligate all award funds by December 31, 2024, and expend funds by December 31, 2026 as outlined in the Obligation Interim Final Rule issued by the Treasury in November of 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed and discussed the proposed eligible uses for the ARPA funds and the Town Board now wishes to encumber all ARPA Funds to specific projects located within the Town of Homer pursuant to and in compliance with all SLFRF and ARPA rules and regulations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Homer, as follows:

1. This resolution shall adopt and appropriate, as an Encumbrance, the ARPA funds in the General Fund budget for Fiscal Year 2025 in the amount of \$318,870.84 for public safety to include renovations of the Town Hall to accommodate Police department and community room renovations, emergency generator installation, and bridge repair.
2. Renovations and repairs are to be started in 2025 and completed no later than December 31, 2026.
3. The Town Supervisor is authorized to immediately act upon this resolution and to complete any paperwork or records necessary to implement the encumbrance.
4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
