TOWN BOARD RESOLUTION NO. [RESOLUTION NUMBER]
A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 2025 TOWN BUDGET**

The following Resolution was offered by _____ and seconded by _____:

WHEREAS, the Town of Homer adopted its 2025 Town Budget on November 13, 2024, and

WHEREAS, certain adjustments to the budget are necessary to reflect changes in personnel and corresponding adjustments to salary and benefits, specifically for the Dog Control Officer and the Highway Superintendent, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed and discussed the proposed amendments to the budget as detailed below, and

WHEREAS, these adjustments do not violate the overall budgetary constraints or tax levy limits set by the State of New York or other applicable laws, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Homer, as follows:

1. On the General A Budget, the following adjustments shall be made:
 - o Dog Control (A3510.1): Reduce the Dog Control Officer salary from \$11,500 to \$10,506 (a reduction of \$994).
 - o Hospital & Medical Insurance (A9060.8): Increase the Hospital & Medical Insurance allocation by \$994 to offset the reduction in the Dog Control Officer salary.
2. On the General A Budget, the following adjustments shall be made:
 - o Highway Superintendent Salary (A5010.1): Reduce the Highway Superintendent salary from \$73,400 to \$62,856 (a reduction of \$10,544) to reflect the new appointment and related salary adjustment.
 - o Hospital & Medical Insurance (A9060.8): Increase the Hospital & Medical Insurance allocation by \$10,544 to account for the health insurance coverage provided to the new Highway Superintendent.
3. These changes reflect personnel adjustments and the associated benefits and salary allocations. The Town Supervisor is authorized and directed to make any necessary adjustments to the budgetary records to reflect these amendments and to take any further actions necessary to implement the changes described above.
4. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
